Art Vocabulary:

Elements of Art: Basic visual symbols in the language of art.

- **Line:** the path of a moving point through space. (Vertical, horizontal, diagonal, curved, zig-zag)
- **Value:** the darkness or lightness of an object.
- **Color:** derived from reflected light.
- **Shape:** a two-dimensional area that is defined in some way. (Geometric or free-form)
- **Form:** objects having three-dimensions.
- **Texture:** refers to how things feel, or look as if they might feel if touched.
- **Space:** refers to the emptiness or area between, around, above, below, or within objects.

Principles: Rules that govern how artists organize the elements of art.

- **Repetition:** a motif or single element that appears again and again.
- **Emphasis:** one part of a work that is dominant over the other parts.
- **Variety:** difference or contrast between the elements/principles
- **Contrast:** technique for creating a focal point by using differences in elements.
- **Unity:** the quality of wholeness or oneness within an artwork.
- **Balance:** equalizing visual forces, or elements, in a work of art.
- **Rhythm:** indicates movement by the repetition of elements.
- **Proportion:** size relationships of one part to another.
- **Scale:** size as measured against a standard reference.
